The INPC 2022 will be held, for the first time on the African continent, in Cape Town, South Africa from 11 to 16 September 2022. Held every three years, the conference follows those in Glasgow 2019, Adelaide 2016 and Florence 2013. The INPC series is overseen by the International Union of Pure and Applied Physics (IUPAP).

The conference program spans a wide range of topics and is inspired by the very latest results, developments and innovative ideas across the breadth of nuclear physics, from hadrons to nuclei, fundamental science to applications.

- Nuclear Structure
- Nuclear Reactions
- Nuclear Astrophysics

- Quantum Computing, Machine Learning and Artificial Intelligence in Nuclear Physics
- Science Outreach and Education

DAY TOURS

CAPE TOWN HIGHLIGHTS FULL DAY TOUR

Experience the highlights and gain an appreciation for the natural beauty of the Cape Peninsula. Travel along the Atlantic seaboard via Hout Bay and the iconic Chapman's Peak Drive. Visit the Cape Point Nature Reserve at the southern tip of the Cape Peninsula; a feature that has captivated travellers and explorers for centuries with its dramatic scenery and fascinating history. Visit the quaint villages of Kalk Bay and St James. CURRENCY

The Rand is the official currency of South Africa and foreign currency can be exchanged at the Cape Town International Airport, at commercial banks and at any Bureaux de Change.

LANGUAGE

English is the main business and academic language; although there are 11 official languages in South Africa.

The main local languages spoken are English, Afrikaans and Xhosa.

With large numbers of foreign residents, Cape Town also has significant German, Dutch, French, Chinese and Spanish communities with the available language skills to assist during an international business event.

TIME ZONE

South African Time is GMT +2. There are no time differences within South Africa and no daylight saving time. Shopping hours vary but shops are typically open from Monday to Sunday, 9 am – 5.30 pm. Weight is indicated by grams and kilograms. Temperature is mainly measured in degrees Celsius.

CLIMATE

South Africa is known for its long sunny days throughout the year. Most of the country experiences rain in summer, however the west coast experience predominantly winter rainfall. Average day temperature in summer range from minimum 15 °C (59 °F) to maximum of 28 °C (82 °F).

VISA INFORMATION

Requirements for entering South Africa

You will need the following if you wish to visit South Africa:

- A valid and acceptable passport or travel document for your intended stay
- At least one blank page in your passport for endorsements
- A valid visa, if required Sufficient funds to pay for your day-to-day expenses during your stay
- A return or onward ticket

Yellow fever certificates if your journey starts or entails passing through the yellow fever belt of Africa or South America.

Countries exempt from South African Visas

PASSPORT HOLDERS WHO ARE EXEMPT FROM VISAS FOR SOUTH AFRIC SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITHOUT NOTICE

The citizen who is a holder of a national passport (diplomatic, official and ordinary) of the foreign countries / territories / international organisations listed below are not required to hold a visa when reporting to an immigration officer for an examination at a South African port of entry, subject to the terms and conditions set out in this list, including inter alia the intended period of stay in the Republic.

1. The holder of a national South African passport, travel document and document for travel purposes.

2. The citizen who is a holder of a national passport (diplomatic, official or ordinary) of the following countries / territories / international organisations is not required to hold a visa in respect of purposes for which a visitor's

permit may be issued or by virtue of being a person contemplated in section 31(3)(b) [accredited in SA] for an intended stay of 90 days or less and when in transit:

- African Union Laissez Passer
- Andorra
- Argentina
- Australia
- Austria
- Belgium
- Botswana
- Brazil
- Canada
- Chile (only ordinary passport holders)
- Czech Republic

HEALTH

Travellers from areas infected by yellow fever must carry a vaccination certificate; otherwise no vaccinations are required. There is a malaria risk in the low-lying areas of the Northern Province and Mpumalanga (including the Kruger National Park), as well as northeastern KwaZulu-Natal, and precautions are advised when travelling to these areas, especially between October and May. Vaccinations are recommended for hepatitis A, hepatitis B and typhoid.

Tap water is generally safe in urban areas but sterilisation is advisable elsewhere. Medical facilities in South Africa are good in urban areas, but medical insurance is strongly advised, as private hospitals expect cash up front and public hospitals are best avoided. Medication is readily available in major cities, but those travelling outside of these centres for an extended period should bring a basic supply kit for emergency self-treatment.

TEMPORARY MEASURES IN RESPECT OF FOREIGN NATIONALS IN LIGHT OF THE COVID-19 EPIDEMIC

People who are allowed into South Africa are still subject to the prescribed screening procedures and isolation or quarantine rules, as the case may be, which include:

1. Provision of a valid certificate of a negative COVID-19 test obtained not more than 72 hours before the date of travel; and
2. in the event of failure to submit a certificate as proof of a negative COVID-19 test, such person will be required to do an antigen test at his or her own cost and if he or she tests positive to COVID-19, he or she will be required to quarantine at his or her own costs.
