

## Accommodation Options for ATLAS HL-LHC Director's Review, July 29-31

The hotels listed below are suggested by Columbia. For Columbia preferred hotels and negotiated rates see [https://www.campustravel.com/university/columbia/hotel\\_rates.pdf](https://www.campustravel.com/university/columbia/hotel_rates.pdf). I note that the rate shown in the pdf file does not match the rate you actually get when you go to the Columbia booking site (clicking on the hotel links in the pdf) – so don't rely on what is printed on the list. Where a room rate is given below, it is the cheapest rate I could find for the period 7/28-7/31 based on a snapshot taken on 6/4/19. You may be able to get other/better rates on your own at other hotels but be aware that hotels fill up quickly so acting soon is a good idea. For your reference the venue will be near the Columbia Physics Department which is located on W120th St near Broadway. The hotels are roughly listed by travel time from the physics department. Lately the subway on time performance hasn't been great, so be aware of that for the more distant hotels. That said, the subway is usually the most convenient and fastest way to get around. Do not rent a car if you plan on staying in the city – street parking should only be attempted by experts and garage parking is expensive.

We have made a **group booking at the Aloft hotel** (see below for details). The rate is \$185/night + tax for a King. To get that group rate go to the following link (the rate is valid for stays from July 26-August 1 should you want to stay longer):

### Teacher's College Guest Housing

Probably closest housing to the Physics Department (5 min walk). They have 15 rooms, each with double beds and private bathroom (see <https://www.tc.columbia.edu/housing/guest-and-conference-housing/guest-housing/> for room description). They currently have availability but there is a strange catch. If you arrive on a weekend, e.g. Sunday July 28, then you have to pay for the full weekend, namely Fri + Sat +Sun. If you arrive and depart on a weekday, then the rates are \$155/night for 1-2 night stays, and \$145/night for 3 or more night stays. Make sure you mention that you are attending a Columbia Physics Dept conference since they restrict who can book.

There is also "Conference Housing" with rooms with private baths, a/c. Rooms w/o kitchen have twin XL bed \$125/night for 1-6 nights. Also room with private kitchen have full XL size bed for \$145/night for 1-6 nights. 3-night stay (7/28-7/31) Standard Queen/Double \$152/night + tax. This hotel is near midtown and Columbus Circle. If you want to be closer than the above hotels to the crowds and theatre this is probably a good choice. You are a block away from the #1 (red) line subway at 59<sup>th</sup> St-Columbus circle which you would take to 116<sup>th</sup> St-Columbia. Probably about 23 min to get to the physics department.

Columbia rate (7/28-7/31) Standard Queen \$179/night + tax. This hotel is near the Columbia medical school and about 2.5 mi away. It is conveniently located near the 165<sup>th</sup> St subway stop for the #1 (red) to W116<sup>th</sup> St-Columbia, or A (express) or C (local) to W125<sup>th</sup> St. Plan on about 30min total travel time to get to the physics department.

### The Travel Inn Hotel

Double Double room (7/28-7/31) \$200/night + tax. If you want to be near Times Square (this hotel is a few blocks from there on the far west side) and walking distance to the Theatre, then this is a good choice. Since you are far west, you would walk to Times Square (13min) and then take the #1 (red) subway from 42<sup>nd</sup> St to 116<sup>th</sup> St-Columbia. Total travel time to the physics department is probably 35min.
