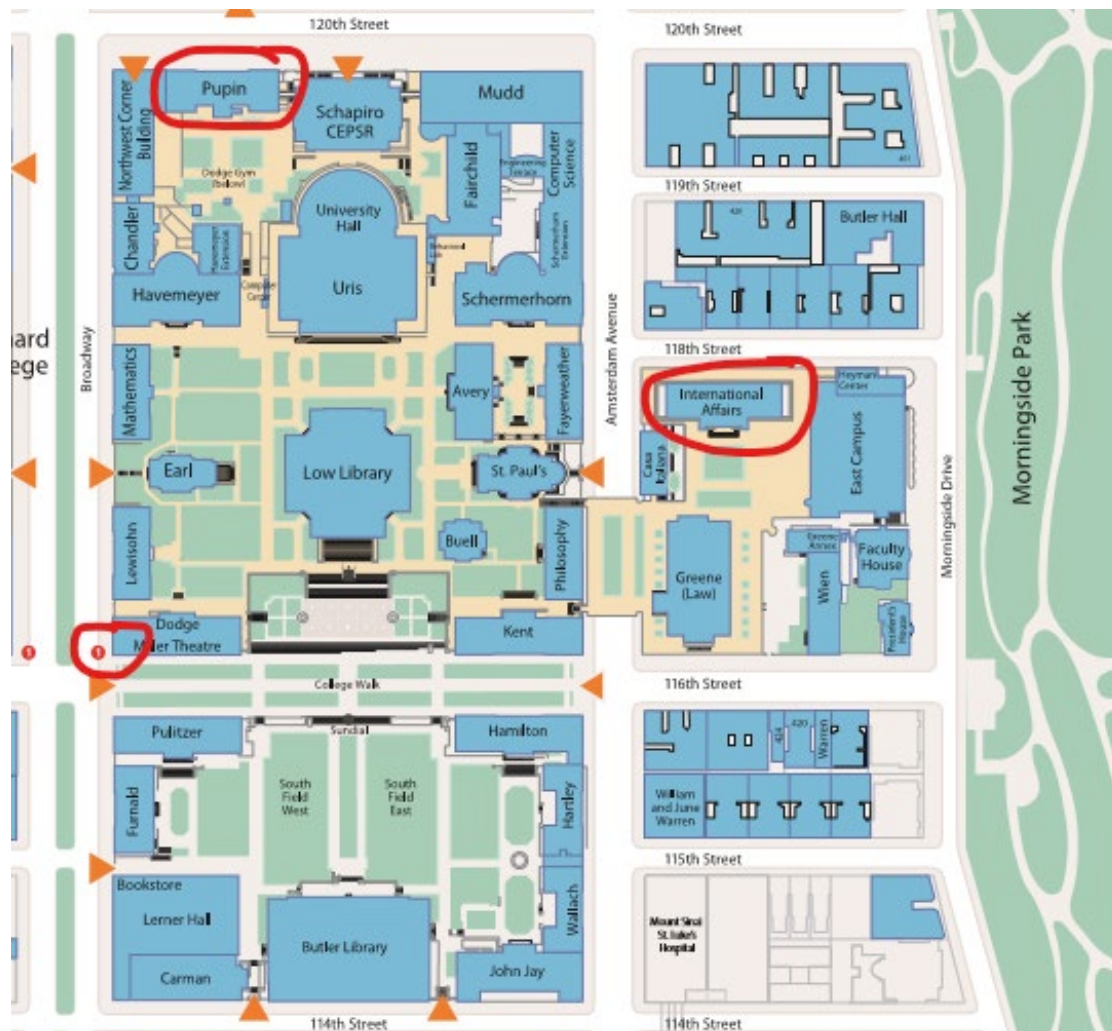


Meeting Venue Information – Director’s Review for NSF FDR

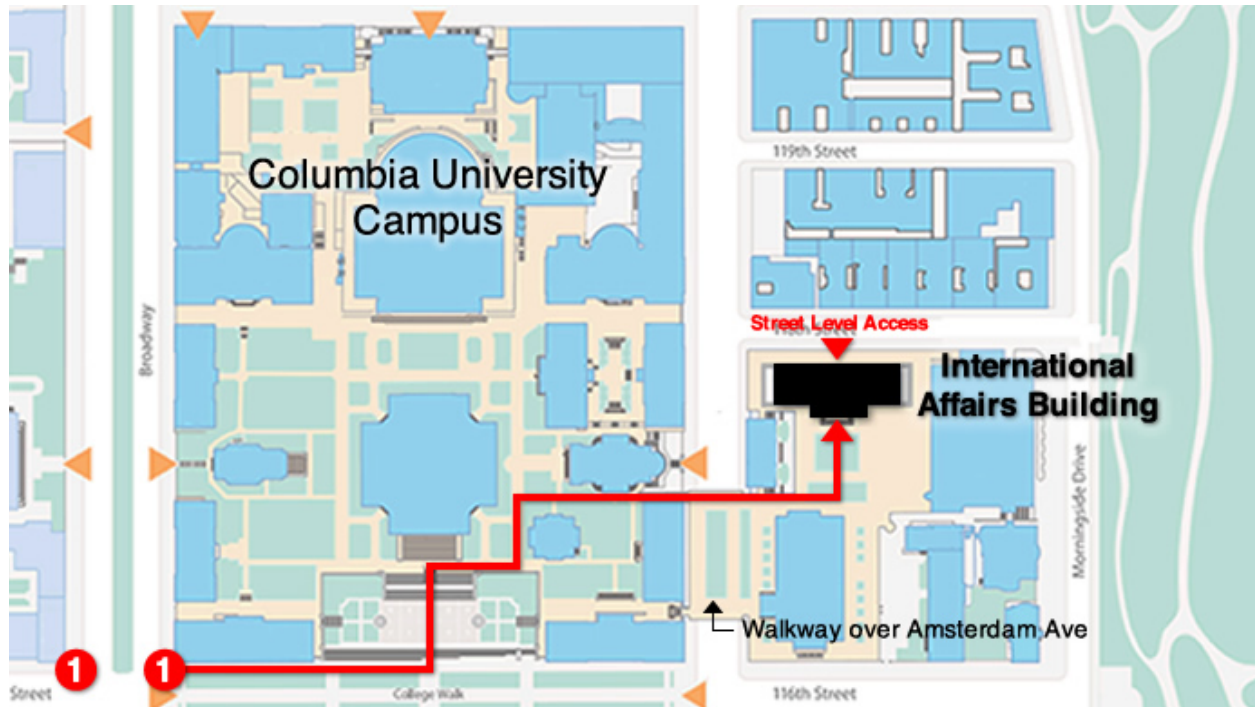
The review will be held on the Columbia University campus. The campus is quite compact and you can find maps at <https://visit.columbia.edu/content/maps-and-directions-update> . A map of the Columbia campus is shown below with:

- the Physics Building (Pupin) circled in red in the upper left corner (on 120th St near Broadway). I have reserved informal meeting space in the Pupin should you want space to meet. Rooms reserved are 705 (seats 30, with A/V), 814 (seats 20, no A/V, just blackboard), 907 (seats about 10 around conference table, has screen you can connect to). The entrance to Pupin is via campus, or you can enter from the ground floor of the Northwest Corner building (see map) where you will see a door into Pupin.
- the review venue International Affairs Building circled in red on the right-middle side of the map on 118th St. Meeting rooms are on 15th floor.
- the #1 subway stop circled in red at Broadway and 116th St
- the public entrances to campus are indicated with orange triangles



Venue Details

The meeting will be held in the International Affairs Building (IAB, also called SIPA sometimes) on the Columbia campus. You can access the building from both the street (street level entrance on W118th St (between Amsterdam Ave and Morningside Drive) or from the campus side (see the map below that shows a path from the #1 subway stop to IAB).



The review will be held on the 15th floor in the following rooms:

- Room 1500 (foyer). Registration and location of food/coffee/tea etc. Includes 5 high tables & registration and food tables. Has wifi (“eduroam”, and open “Columbia University”).
- Room 1501. Room for Plenary and breakouts. Front row tables for reviewers (12 places at tables) + 50 seats in room. Some tables with seats at side of room. Screen with PC and phone conference ability. Will have some power strips in room. Has wifi (“eduroam”, and open “Columbia University”).
- Room 1512. Room for breakouts. Seats 40 around U shaped table. Additional chairs on east wall. Screen with PC and phone conference ability. Will have some power strips in room. Has wifi (“eduroam”, and open “Columbia University”).
- Room 1510. Ad-hoc meeting room, not required for review but can be used by participants. Seats 14 at table with seats around wall that could seat additional 20. Has wifi (“eduroam”, and open “Columbia University”).
